### **Directions**

**From I-275** take Exit 52 (Loveland/Indian Hill) toward Loveland. Turn left onto Loveland Madeira Road. Turn right onto E. Kemper Road. Turn right onto W. Loveland Avenue. Turn left onto N. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (OH-48). Continue straight onto Cozaddale-Murdock Road. Community is one mile on right.

**From I-71** take Exit 28 (South Lebanon). Go south on OH-48 for 6.8 miles. Turn left on Cozaddale-Murdock Road. Community is one mile on right.
